"Who is wise? Let them realize these things. Who is discerning? Let them understand. The ways of the LORD are right; the righteous walk in them, but the rebellious stumble in them."

(Hosea 14:9)

2- The righteous walk in them: The righteous man will be happy and glad to walk in the ways of the Lord, because they are God's provision for his life. The righteous recognize that the ways of the Lord are God's love and mercy for him and he is happy to walk in them.

3- But the rebellious stumble in them: The rebellious will make many excuses and lies to justify their disobedience and their unwillingness to follow the commands of God. They will accuse, put the fault on someone else and they will give faulty reasons in order for them to escape the going in the ways of the Lord.

But you should not be among those people, God calling you to repent and follow His ways and be among the wise and the understanding.
