Tell _____: The Lord is giving a clear instruction to each and everyone of us. Here God is speaking to **Archippus**, and in every occasion He is speaking specifically to each person of us. God calls us and instruct us by name.

When we are indiligent and when we are delinquent God is reminding us of the things that we commit ourselves to do but we fail to achieve.

See to it: God is directing us specifically to the area that needs to be perfected in our lives and the task that we need to complete. Everyone one of us God had given Him a responsibility to do and He is after us until we complete that.

That you complete: Many they start to do certain ministry and service unto God but they don’t complete it. God want us to complete the task. The Word of God admonish us to complete the task that we had started, **“Now finish the work, so that your eager willingness to do it may be matched by your completion of it,**

*according to your means.” (2 Corinthians 8:11) Don’t keep the work half way and leave it to do other things. That is not acceptable so you must **complete the ministry you have received in the Lord.***

God had entrusted you with a certain task and His eyes today on you wanting you to finish that particular task. This is what the Holy Spirit is speaking: **“These are the words of him who holds the seven spirits of God and the seven stars. I know your deeds; you have a reputation of being alive, but you are dead. ² Wake up! Strengthen what remains and is about to die, for I have found your deeds unfinished in the sight of my God. Remember, therefore, what you have received and heard; hold it fast, and repent. But if you do not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what time I will come to you.” (Revelation 3:2-3)**
