

“Then I will purify the lips of the peoples, that all of them may call on the name of the LORD and serve him shoulder to shoulder. At that time I will deal with all who oppressed you. I will rescue the lame; I will gather the exiles. I will give them praise and honor in every land where they have suffered shame. I will give you honor and praise among all the peoples of the earth when I restore your fortunes before your very eyes,” says the LORD.” (Zephaniah 3:18-20)
