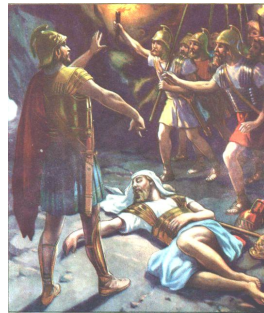
1- Wait for the LORD: You need to wait patiently upon God and to be in prayer and
