## "Consider the blameless, observe the upright; a future awaits those who seek peace."

(Psalms 37:37)



1- Consider the blameless: A black dot on a white shirt will spoil it. The blame or the error, or the fault or the defect that will be appearing and spoil the materials that have it. The same will be for you; a small wrong thing in your life, attitude and character will spoil your testimony. That is why you are admonished through this message to consider the blameless, the person without blame or error and imitate that.

**2- Observe the upright:** See and pick up the good things from the life of the person who live in godliness and who go on and do God's will and plan in His life. The upright is a decent, honest, respectable, moral and conscientious person. You need to observe and imitate such peoples' life.

Why the Word of God admonish us to consider these two characters, the blameless and the upright? Because such quality of people are doing their best to live their lives unto God. They have the characters of patience, perseverance, bearing under injustice, forgiveness attitude, and fully trusting in God are their strategy and procedures. They are led by the Spirit of God to do the work of God and be the testimony and the inspiration for others to live their lives unto God.

And to them the following is true, "Peacemakers who sow in peace reap a harvest of righteousness." (James 3:18) They do the work of God quietly and achieving great things for God by applying God's word on reality and practice it.

Such kind of people they are highly esteemed by the Lord and they will be richly rewarded. We need to persevere to observe such kind of good quality life discipline to be fruitful and effective in His Kingdom.
