2- Maintain Justice: *Avoid favouritism and two different scales measure. Don’t put oppressive rules and unrealistic things that are not practical.*

3- Wait for your God always: *Don’t be in hurry to do your own but wait upon God. Be faithful to Him by listening to His instructions.*
