"Wine is a mocker, strong drink is a brawler, and whoever is led astray by it is not wise."



Many they justified drinking and they use even the Scripture to support their views and their desires but the above word of God described wine and alcohol in the right way; wine or alcohol are mocker, brawler and lead people astray.

One reason is because alcohol consumption is too seductive. One drink easily leads to another. In only a few minutes, drinking lowers a person's resistance to certain behaviors. Alcohol wields an unpredictable influence. And we should refuse to submit control of our minds and actions to its seductiveness.

"And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit." (Ephesians 5:18) It is impossible for you to surrender your will to the Holy Spirit and alcohol at the same time. The Holy Spirit will lead you to Jesus Christ who is The King of Kings and the Lord of Lords. The Lord will take you to heaven as you walk in His way. But Alcohol will confuse your mind and let you go down following evil desires and going on wrong ways that leads to death and hell.

Another reason you should not drink is because alcohol ruins lives. Addiction will cost you all your money; you may lose your job, your most important relationships, your family and your dignity. **Proverbs** 23:21 warns,

"for drunkards and gluttons become poor, and drowsiness clothes them

in rags." That poverty means on various fields of your life.


Alcohol kills; it causes road traffic accidents. It is responsible for violent crimes, including murder and suicides.
