(Proverbs 11:26)



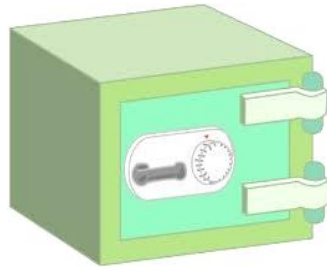
Our God is a Lord of Blessings and a God who love and care for His people who love Him and walk in His ways.
